<u>Notice and Request for Comment</u> – Publishing for comment New Brunswick Securities Commission Local Policy 72-601 – *Distributions of Securities outside New Brunswick* (LP 72-601).

Introduction

On 18 December 2006, the New Brunswick Securities Commission (the Commission) approved publication for comment of LP 72-601.

Substance and Purpose

LP 72-601 does not grant exemptions from the prospectus and registration requirements but, in effect, outlines when a distribution is not subject to New Brunswick securities laws. LP 72-601 also will assist issuers and selling securityholders in structuring transactions.

Request for Comment

The Commission seeks comments on the proposed LP 72-601 and invites comments also on the specific matters referred to below:

- 1. Does LP 72-601 provide sufficient clarity to the public?
- 2. Is there an alternative approach to formulating a statement of policy regarding distributions outside New Brunswick that is more appropriate for the New Brunswick market?
- 3. Are the "connecting factors" the most relevant factors for determining jurisdiction? Are there others that are appropriate?
