**CONSENT ORDER**

**WHEREAS** the Applicant has applied for an order pursuant to subsection 23(1)(b) of the *Security Frauds Prevention Act*, R.S.N.B. 1973, c. S-6 (the "*Act*"), as amended, absolutely enjoining each of the Respondents from trading in any security whatsoever in New Brunswick and consequently, from committing a fraudulent act as defined in section 1 of the *Act*;

**AND HAVING READ** the Notice of Application and the Affidavits filed in support;

**AND UPON THE CONSENT** of the Respondents as indicted by their solicitors below;

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that:

1. Subject to paragraph 2, the Respondents, Locate Technologies Inc. and Tubtron Controls Corp. are enjoined from trading in any security whatsoever in New Brunswick, notwithstanding any certificate or order previously issued by the Administrator, without first obtaining from the Administrator a certificate or order that authorizes trading pursuant to the *Act*.
2. Locate Technologies Inc. and Tubtron Controls Corp. may, upon the application or request of a New Brunswick shareholder, accept the rescission of that shareholder's subscription agreement with said company or companies. In each case these Respondents shall within ten days of such rescission notify the Administrator under the *Act* of the rescission.
3. The Respondent Lorne Drever is enjoined from trading in any security whatsoever in New Brunswick, notwithstanding any certificate or order previously issued by the Administrator, without first complying with the provisions of the *Act* for the registration of brokers and salesmen. However, he is permitted to trade in securities in New Brunswick through a registered broker or registered salesman for his personal account and the account of his spouse.
4. The Respondent Harry Niles is enjoined from trading in any security whatsoever in New Brunswick, notwithstanding any certificate or order previously issued by the Administrator, without

first complying with the provisions of the Act for the registration of brokers and salesmen. However, he is permitted to trade in securities in New Brunswick through a registered broker or registered salesman for his personal account and the account of his spouse.

5. The Respondents Bradley Corporate Services Ltd. and 500988 N.B. Ltd. are enjoined absolutely from trading in any security whatsoever in New Brunswick, notwithstanding any certificate or order previously issued by the Administrator. However, they may through a registered broker or registered salesman carry on such trading as may be necessary for the sole purpose of liquidating such securities as they may hold at the date of this order under their respective corporate names.


