

## NOTICE 15-705 FROM THE OFFICE OF THE SECRETARY **ADJOURNMENT REQUESTS**

## **4 January 2013**

Notice to parties in proceedings governed by the New Brunswick Securities Commission's Local Rule 15-501 Proceedings before a Panel of the Commission (LR 15-501).

This notice relates to requests for adjournment under subsections 14(5), 14(5.1) and 14(5.2) of LR 15-501.

Part 5 of LR 15-501 provides that any Party requesting an adjournment must advise the Secretary and all parties of the adjournment request at the earliest possible opportunity. The request must contain reasons for the request and any supporting documentation.

If all Parties consent to the adjournment request, a written notification must be filed with the Office of the Secretary advising of the consent at the earliest possible opportunity. The request and notification of consent will then be brought to the attention of the Panel. The Panel will review the documentation and advise the Parties of their decision on the adjournment.

If there is <u>no consent</u>, the Party requesting an adjournment must file and serve a Motion for the adjournment. The Motion must be filed in accordance with Part 6 of LR 15-501, and follow the timelines set out in LR 15-501.

Adjournment requests will not be considered by the Panel unless they are received as set about above, and detailed in subsections 14(5.1) and 14(5.2) of LR 15-501.

This notice is effective immediately.
