As a Compliance Officer you will conduct investigations/reviews from start to finish including activities such as: site visits; personal interviews; collecting and reviewing information from various sources to assist with substantiating or dismissing allegations; preparing investigative reports; arrange for hearings, attend and testify at hearings when required and conduct inspections of insurers, agencies, brokerages and/or individuals.

You possess excellent oral and written communications skills, strong analytical and detail oriented skills. You are able to work independently as well as in a team environment and have excellent interpersonal skills.
