



NOTICE OF RULE

MAKING OF AMENDMENTS TO RULE INS-001

INSURANCE INTERMEDIARIES LICENSING AND OBLIGATIONS

The Minister of Finance and Treasury Board is deemed to have consented to the making of the above-mentioned amendments on September 7, 2025, after receiving related materials on July 9, 2025. The amendments come into force on October 1, 2025. These amendments:

- Align New Brunswick more closely with the lines of insurance that entry-level agents in other jurisdictions can sell.
- Clarify the expectations with respect to supervision and oversight.
- Add language so that potential applicants from outside New Brunswick can plainly see their rights are respected under the *Canadian Free Trade Agreement*.
- Allow Life and Accident & Sickness agents and agencies to add Travel as part of their application or existing licences.
- Clarify sections for operational or housekeeping purposes.
