Citation: Revocation of Blanket Order 31-504 *In the Matter of an Exemption from Certain Sections of National Instrument 31-103 Registration Requirements and Exemptions in Connection with Transition and Grandfathering Matters*

(Order under subsection 205.1(1) of the Securities Act)

Background

1. Blanket Order 31-504 *In the Matter of an Exemption from Certain Sections of National Instrument 31-103 Registration Requirements and Exemptions in Connection with Transition and Grandfathering Matters* (**BO 31-504**) came into effect on February 26, 2010.
2. Through a delegation order from the Commission to the Executive Director of Securities dated February 8, 2023 (**Delegation Order**), the Commission has delegated to the Executive Director of Securities the Commission's power under subsection 205.1(1) of the *Securities Act* (New Brunswick) (**Act**) to make an order revoking or varying a decision of the Commission that has been made by the Executive Director pursuant to the Delegation Order.

Order

3. The Executive Director of Securities, considering that it would not be prejudicial to the public interest to do so, orders under subsections 205.1(1) of the *Act* that BO 31-504 is revoked.

Effective Date

4. This order comes into effect on March 27, 2026.
